PARKING POLICIES-NEW PARKRIDGE AND DEBORAH STRONG HOUSING

Dear Residents,

It's almost SPRING!!! With that being said we ask that all residents that own a vehicle to please come into the office starting April 1st through April 19th to register your vehicle and receive your 2021 parking permit. We are only issuing one (1) parking permit per apartment. If you have registered your vehicle in the past you still need to register and receive your new parking permit. Older permits will no longer be valid.

Please keep in mind according to the Community Rules and Regulations Policy #33 all vehicles must be registered with Management identifying the Landlord of said vehicle, year, make and license plate number. All vehicles must be operable, registered and licensed. Management shall have the right to remove all inoperable, unregistered or unlicensed vehicles from the premises at the resident's expense and resident must reimburse management for all costs incurred in removing said vehicle.

Once all vehicles are registered they will go into a database with the appropriate permit number and a copy will be given to security. If YPD, Security, or the Management office shall see an unregistered vehicle it will be towed immediately. At this time, we ARE NOT issuing visitor passes. We ask that your visitors park in the YHC parking lot after business hours and in the guest parking during business hours only.

Hello All,




