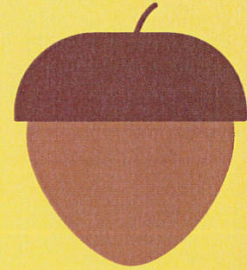

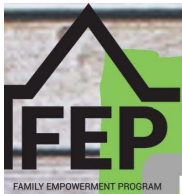

WINTER PROGRAMS INFORMATION

2019-2020

When is the winter shelter open? – November 11th, 2019 – March 31st, 2020 pending weather conditions. Shelter is available each night beginning at 6:30pm after 5pm onsite dinner (all are welcome for dinner as well!). Beds are set-up at 8:30pm.

Who is eligible? – Any individuals seeking emergency shelter during the cold, winter months. Families, please contact Housing Access of Washtenaw County at 734-961-1999 to be referred to appropriate shelter resources.

What is provided? – Individuals are provided a safe place to sleep each night at the Delonis Center and can access a wide variety of services onsite including meals, case management, medical care, and most importantly assistance with finding safe, permanent housing.

Where is shelter provided? - Nighttime accommodations are onsite at the Delonis Center; 312 W. Huron St., Ann Arbor, MI 48103.

How do I get into the shelter? – Please contact Housing Access of Washtenaw County and obtain a referral to the Delonis Center. Housing Access can be reached at 734-961-1999. If it is after 5pm, please come to the Delonis Center and we'll assist you onsite.

What about during the daytime? – During the week, daytime shelter accommodations are available at local Congregations at varying times, generally 9am – 4pm. Please contact the Delonis Center for the specific times of each congregation. Day shelter is provided through a partnership with the local group MISSION. Daytime shelter is provided beginning December 2nd and through March 27th. Please see the schedule below for a list of locations. On the weekends, daytime shelter is available at the Delonis Center from 8am-7pm.
